

As part of our continuous optimization of Grundfos Extranet, we are announcing a small change which might impact the way you use Extranet as a customer.

Previously, you have been able to retrieve technical documentation and data on specific products in Extranet, but due to our recent UX changes on Grundfos Product Center the procedures of seeing or extracting this data has now changed slightly.

With effect from **February 24**th **08:00 AM CET** this new procedure replace the current and as such, we kindly advise you to read the following guide which will introduce the new changes and how to reach the outputs.

It is important to notice, that **the contents remain the same** as originally – we are merely changing the way in which you retrieve them.


We apologize for any inconvenience this might incur but hope you will find this guide helpful in understanding the new approach.







The new solution



On Grundfos Extranet

Previously, on the **product detail page**, an "iframe" of **Grundfos Product Center** technical data feature would allow you to interact with and retrieve **technical product data** from GPC directly.

While having reintroduced a new experience on our .com sites and Grundfos Product Center, the visibility of technical details will disappear **from Extranet.**


For you, this means that from Wednesday 24th 08:00 AM CET the iframe will be replaced with a link bar underneath the commercial banner with which you can interact.

The links in the bar represent the different options available for the product and will only appear if data is available (e.g. services)





The new solution



In Product Center / .local sites

Clicking the link in Extranet will take you to the corresponding product detail page in Grundfos **Product Center,** with the corresponding tech. details tab pre-exploded.


From here you can retrieve, see, download, etc., the exact same things as previously.

Upon having retrieved the data required, navigating back to Extranet is simply a matter of clicking the "Extranet" tab in your **browser tab bar** on the top of the screen.

On Grundfos Extranet

Where previously in Extranet there would be a "Print PDF"—button to obtain and extract various data sheets (Product data sheets, submittal data, etc.), going forward you will need to do the following steps.


When on a **product detail page** in Grundfos Extranet (see picture) click in the **specifications link** in the lower left corner of the page.

Via Extranet

Clicking the link will take you to the corresponding product detail page in Grundfos Product Center (Grundfos.com/us)

In the **upper right corner** of the commercial banner you will find a **print icon**, from where you can download the required details as you would normally.


Upon having retrieved the data required, navigating back to Extranet is simply a matter of clicking the "Extranet" tab in your **browser tab bar** on the top of the screen.

Here you will be able to **search** for the specific product, for which you require the documentation.


You simply need to type in the name or the specific product number in the search bar and click ENTER / click the "search"-icon.


